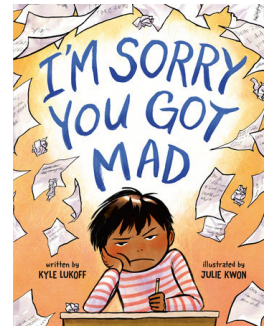


ASL-Interpreted Storytime

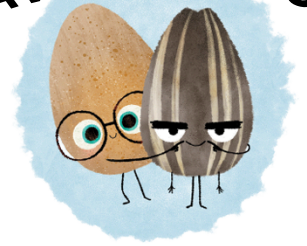
