# SUMMER READING



Summer reading helps maintain and grow critical thinking skills. Students will choose a grade level appropriate book to read over the summer and complete the Summer Reading Assignment for their grade level.\* During the first full week of school, students will turn in the assignment and take an on-demand writing assessment that connects to Unit 1's themes. The book cannot be a part of the East Providence School District's grades 6 - 12 curriculum (for example *The Outsiders*) and must meet at least one of these criteria:

- listed as age 12+ on [Common Sense Media](#), or
- listed as Young Adult on [Goodreads](#), or
- suggested on the [2027 Rhode Island Teen Book Award list](#).
