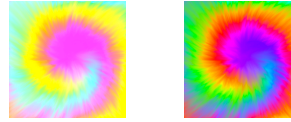


Use upcycled materials and the line and wash technique to create a watercolor nature journal.

## HOW TO D&D

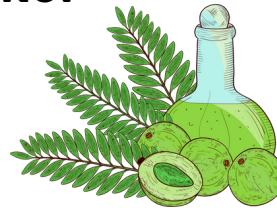
